Your KPT Card

The KPT Card is your insurance card, which you present to providers such as doctors, hospitals and pharmacists within Switzerland and abroad as proof that you are insured by KPT.

The front of the insurance card

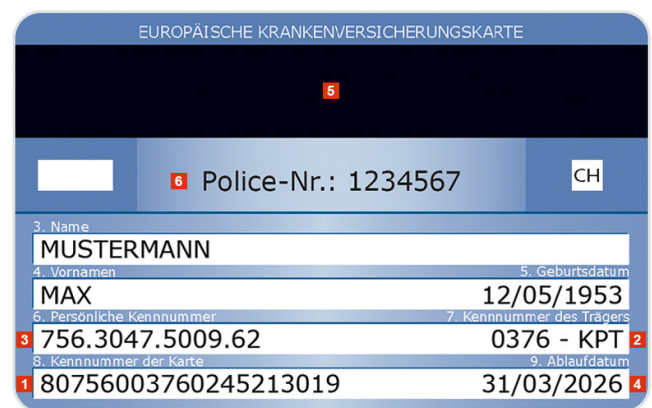
This side is the Swiss health insurance card for **use in Switzerland**.



- 1 All data printed on the card is stored on the chip. You can also ask approved providers such as doctors to store your medical data on the chip.
- 2 The card number is for the current insurance card only. If you receive a new card, this will have a different number.
- 3 You can call the SOS telephone number from Switzerland and abroad for free telemedical advice.
- 4 The FOPH number is the number under which KPT is registered with the Federal Office of Public Health (FOPH).
- 5 Your OASI number must also be included on the card for legal reasons.
- 6 The expiry date is the date until which the insurance card is valid.

The back of the insurance card

This side is the European health insurance card for **use in an EU/EFTA state**.



- 1 The card number is for the current insurance card only. If you receive a new card, this will have a different number.
- 2 The FOPH number is the number under which KPT is registered with the Federal Office of Public Health (FOPH).
- 3 Your OASI number must also be included on the card for legal reasons.
- 4 The expiry date is the date until which the health insurance card is valid.
- 5 The magnetic strip is a transitional solution while compatible readers remain in use. The card number and OASI number are stored on this strip.
- 6 Your basic health insurance policy number serves as your customer number.
